In an attempt to continue this rich tradition more effectively, the College has joined hands with the philanthropic couple; Mr. Anil N. and Mrs. Neeta A. Netravali who have benevolently contributed towards a fellowship in memory of Anil Netravali's parents, Mr. Narayan M. and Mrs. Tarabai N. Netravali. Under this travel fellowship, financial assistance will be made available to a deserving doctoral research student registered with the College to make an oral presentation of research paper at a national seminar / symposium / conference or any other scientific event or session.

Selection of the deserving candidate:

- An intercollegiate research paper competition will be held in the **First Week of September***.
- All research students (science) registered for doctoral degree at Ramnarain Ruia Autonomous College can participate in the competition.
- There is no entry fee.
- There will be one preliminary round of selection before the final round. In the first round, a panel of judges from Ramnarain Ruia Autonomous College will select a maximum of ten students who will compete in the Final round. Only one student, who will be selected by the external panel of judges from some premiere Institute of India, will be named as the deserving candidate for the financial assistance. Judges' decision will be final.

Assistanceship:

- Citation
- Financial assistance upto Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) to meet expenses of attending the national scientific event (travel to and fro by air / train, boarding and lodging up to three days including food)
- The financial assistance can be availed within one calendar year from the date of award.

Competition:

The first round of the competition will be held in **Last Week of August*** at Ramnarain Ruia Autonomous College. The details of the competition for both the rounds will be announced after the registration of participants.
