REPORT OF ACTIVITIES (2023-24)

ACTIVITY 1: PROVISION OF READERS AND WRITERS

The students with Learning Disabilities and those with Visual challenges were given readers and writers throughout the year as and when required. Special provision of writers was made with the help of the Rotaract Club and the NSS Units of the college during the exam.

OUTCOME: This ensured that the students were continuously supported for the learning process and educational purpose.

ACTIVITY 2: CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM

3-Day Career Guidance workshop was conducted by The Self-Vision Centre of Ruia College along with Enable India to orient students to the different career options and the necessary adjustments required for effective Career Adjustment.

DATES: 24th, 25th and 26th August 2023.

13 students (5 Females and 8 Males) attended the workshop

OUTCOME: This workshop oriented students to the various technological equipments that they may use in order to effectively adjust to the newer responsibilities at the job place. It also improved the confidence and the self-esteem of the students towards Occupation and Career adjustments.

ACTIVITY 3: DEMONSTRATION OF THE VOTING PROCEDURE AND USE OF VVPAT MACHINE FOR STUDENTS WITH VISUAL CHALLENGES

The turnout of individuals with Visual challenges is generally low. One of the reasons being apprehension regarding the Voting machine. Students with Visual Challenges who are eligible for voting need to be familiarised with the Voting machine and Voting procedure. With this aim a Workshop was conducted in association with Wadala 180- Matadar Sangh and Snehankit.

Students from Ruia (12 from FYBA, SYBA and TYBA) attended this workshop which was organised in G12 of Ruia College on Monday 26th Feb 2024
Students from other colleges like Poddar College, SIES college and Siddharth College were other beneficiaries of this workshop.

OUTCOME: The students were familiarised with the procedure that they will be required to follow at the Voting booth. Hands on experience was also given to help them to understand the functioning of the VVPAT machine.

This workshop enabled students to understand their role in the voting procedure and participate effectively in the forthcoming Elections.
