4. Coverage of course through practical

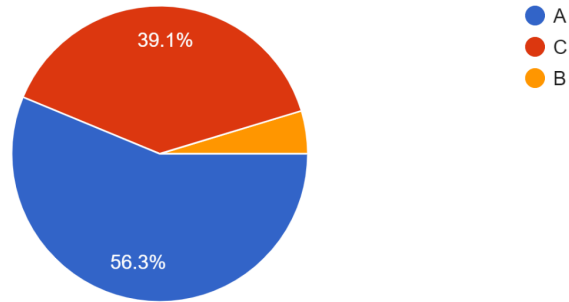
Feedback on curriculum - FYBSc GE course 2023-24 offered by Department of Commerce in SEM I RESGEC0M.0101 and SEM II RESGEC0M.E111

A total of 64 Students gave feedback on curriculum.

1. 40% students found the syllabus to be good 'Relevance of syllabus of course to the current trends of industry' and 31% found it to be average.
2. Students feedback suggested ... Module on Entrepreneurship was highly interesting to majority of students.
3. 46% found the syllabus vast as compared to 26% who found it manageable
4. 40% of the students found the syllabus difficult and 22percent found it easy
5. 31 students almost 45 percent found management skills topic interesting
6. 23 students found Direct marketing, Advertising, Sales promotion interesting whereas majority found it not useful.
7. Make the syllabus more compact.
8. Few topics students suggested to be added in the syllabus: Accounting, Tax management, Balance sheet understanding, Beginner level economics or finance, Practical aspect of commerce, taxes, banking, stock market, bonds and self finance. Stock markets, Finance, Financial topics (FD, savings acc, etc) BASIC financial knowledge. Personal finance management, Economics basic topics, Financial status of the country, Management skills and skills which can be collaterally used with our major subjects to build a career., Accounting and business administration, About banks and loans, Business Laws

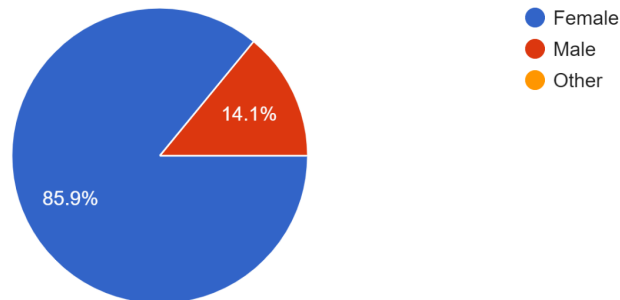

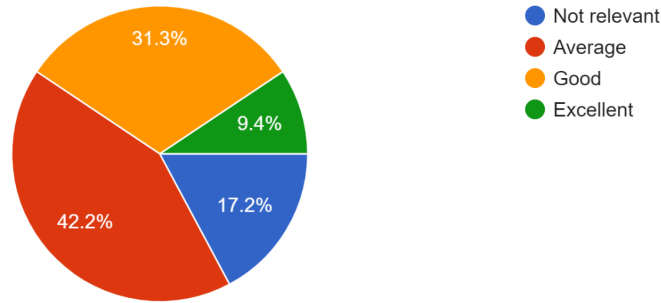
Gender

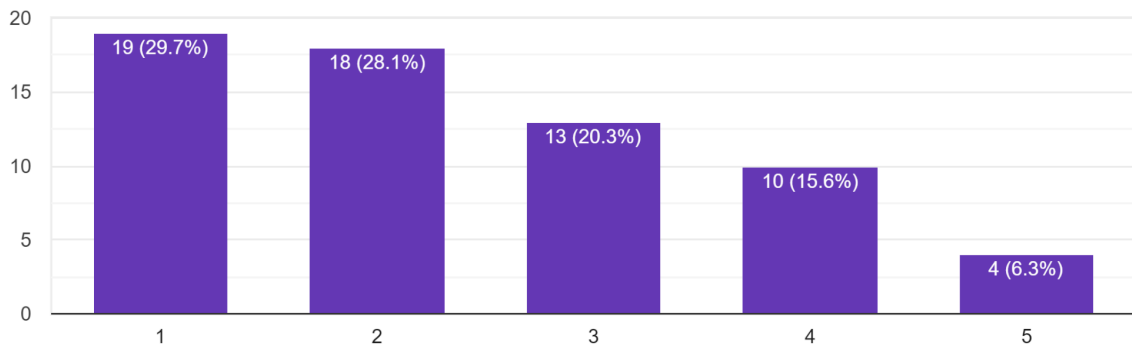
'Relevance of syllabus of course to the current trends of industry'

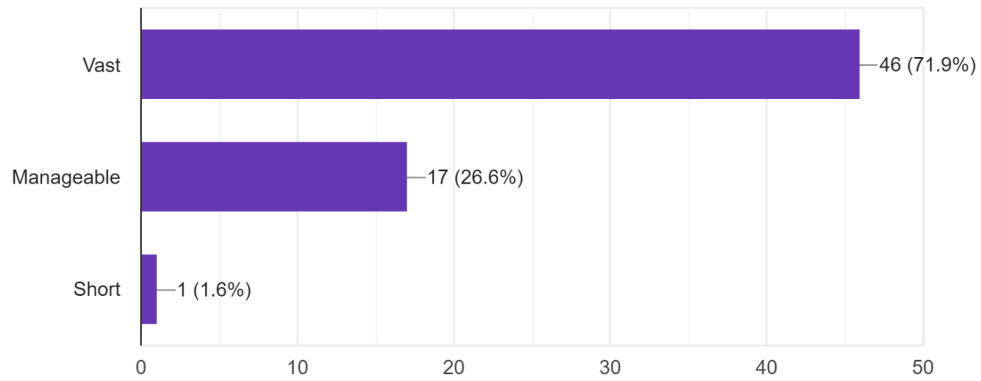
Suitability of the course for Science background students (Please rank from low to high)

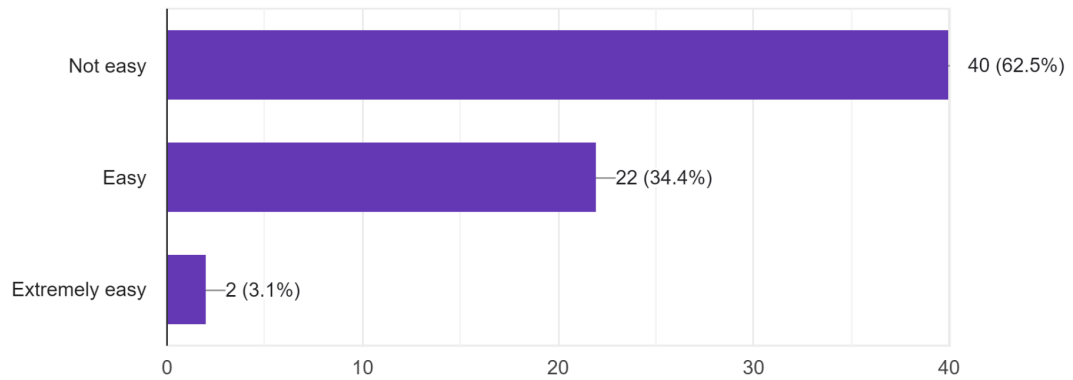
Size of the syllabus

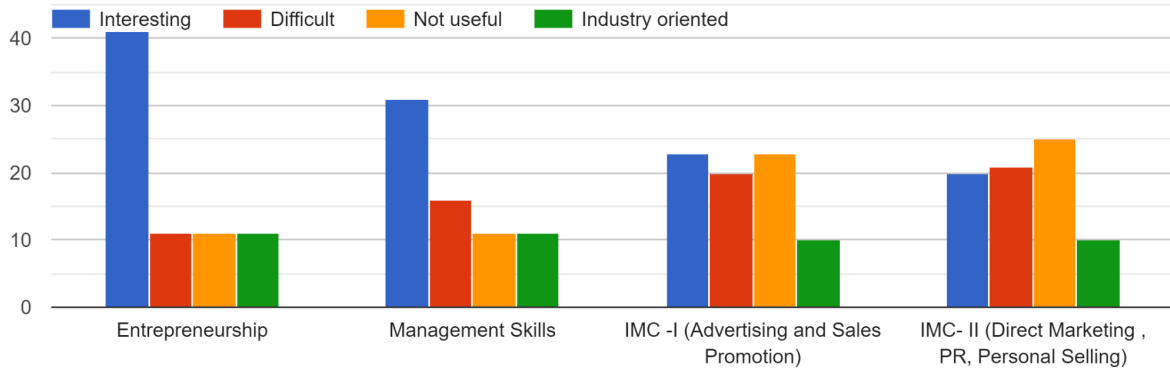


Level of difficulty of the course

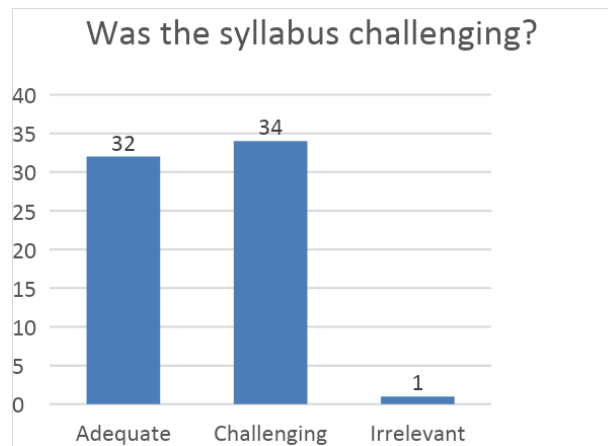

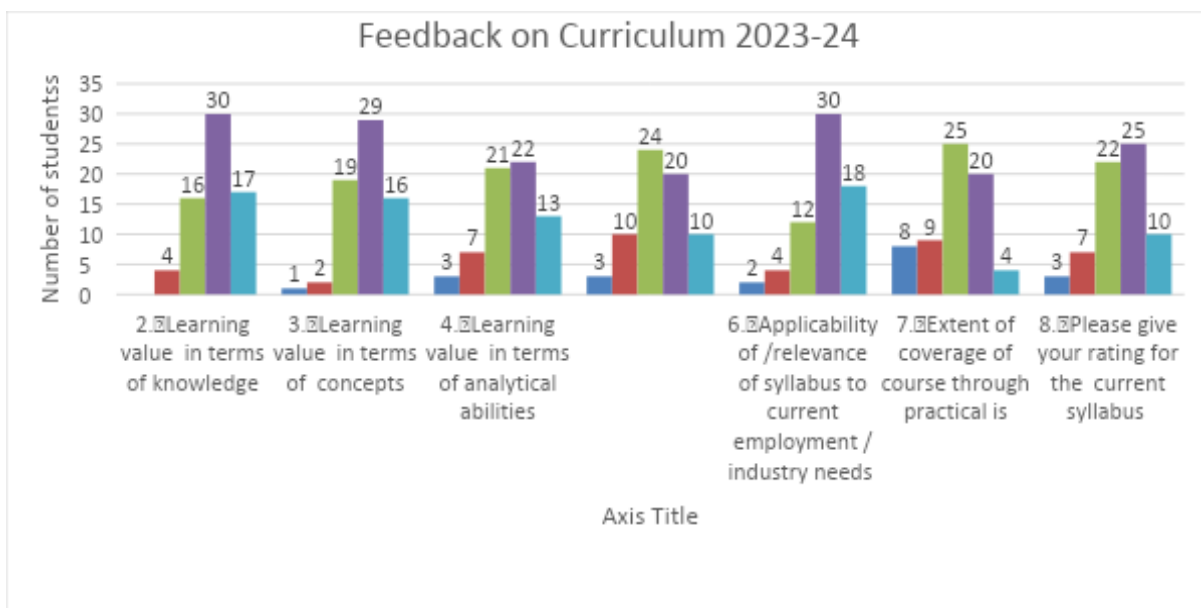


Feedback on Modules in both semesters

A total of 2 Peers gave their feedback on the curriculum.

Peers appreciated the syllabus for being formulated such that competencies are well balanced and progressive with level of study. They appreciated the Course Structure to be well defined and challenging. Appropriate Learning Resources are well defined.

The content defined in the Courses has scope for updating to include contemporary and issues of recent relevance.

Topics included in the syllabus have areas of study relevant to major problems found in society and economy.
