Session 1): The major concern of the talk is the interaction between cinema and literature in early twentieth century. The discussion will try to highlight how mediums grew together at a particular historical juncture through a coincidental correspondence between prominent personalities in both literature and cinema.

Session 2): The discipline of translation studies is an emerging field. Post 70s, it has surpassed the conventional understanding of translation and lead to a more inclusive concept. The talk will give an outline of the discipline and discuss how we encounter translation in our day-to-day life.

Session 3): As we face the pandemic, many things have changed including our language. The speaker will discuss the modulations and nuances of language in the time of pandemic through the lens of literary theory.

Session 4): The history of the book became an acknowledged academic discipline in the 1980s. The development of writing and various other inventions such as paper printing have contributed in its progression. The talk intends to introduce the basics of this field and encourage further research.
