

2.3 Infrastructure and Learning Resources

The N-list was constructed in 2009 by the Government of India which includes about 7000 e-journals, 11 lakh e-books out of which 60% journals are fully downloaded through Ruia library free and open to all students. N-List does not have open access to UG students but can be accessed on request.

Mr. Nimkar suggested starting a Book Club to encourage the students to improve their reading habits. Mr Amogh Desai (Student Representative) supported the idea and showed interest in promoting the idea of a book club among the students. Aarya Patil said students use vacation for reading general books.
