Feedback on curriculum was collected from students in the following areas:

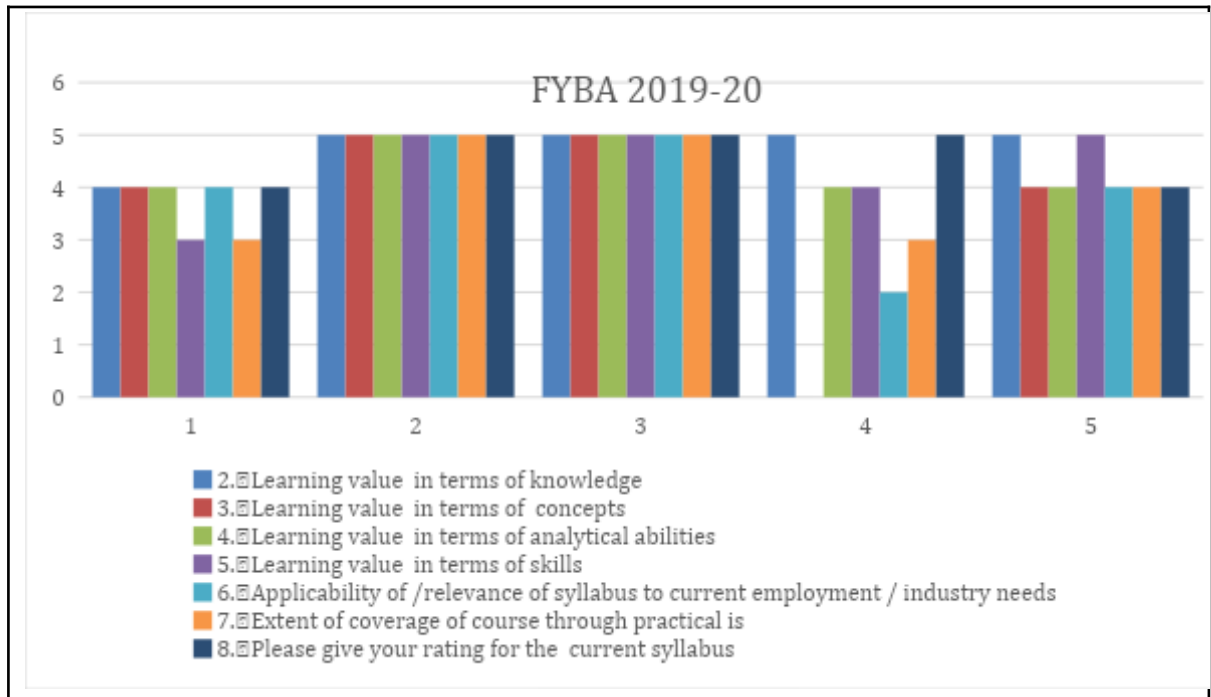
1. Knowledge and Concept

Students feedback suggested that they were satisfied with the curriculum.

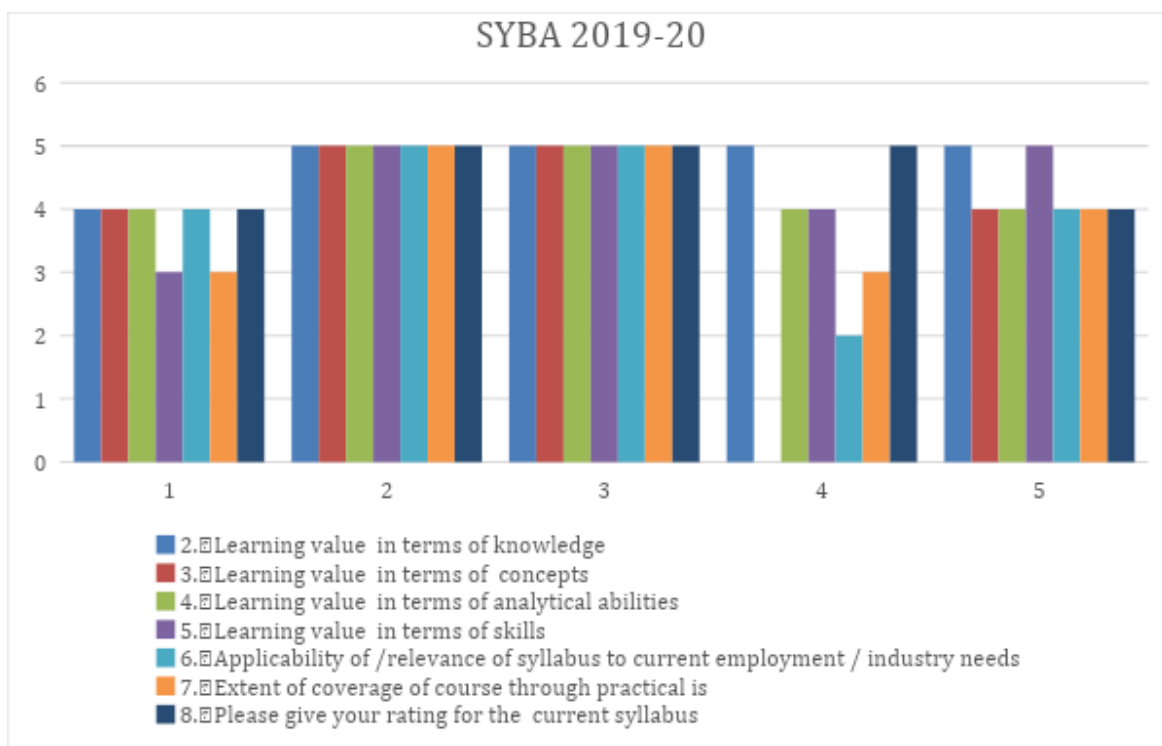


A total of 25 Students gave feedback on curriculum.

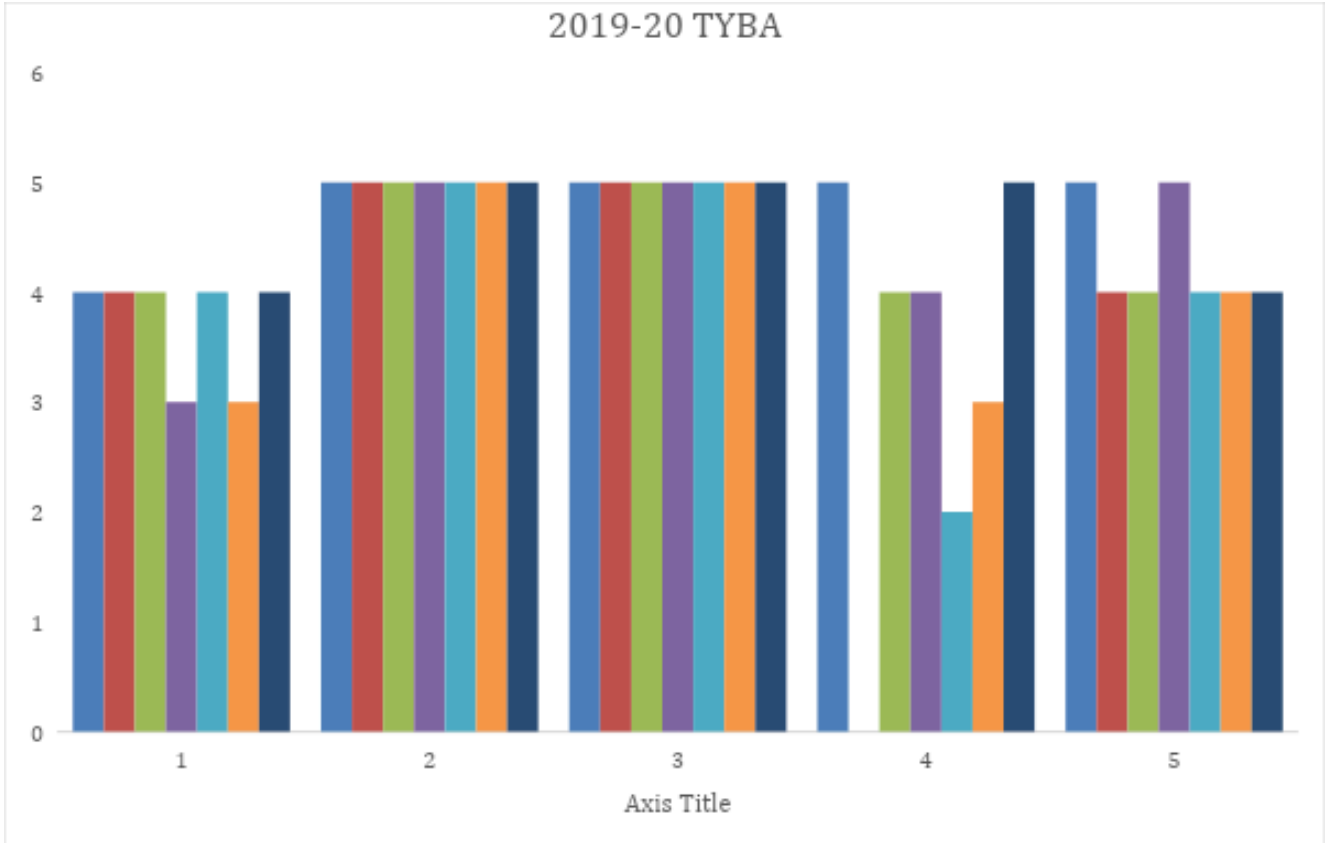
