

Feedback on Curriculum for the academic year 2020-21:

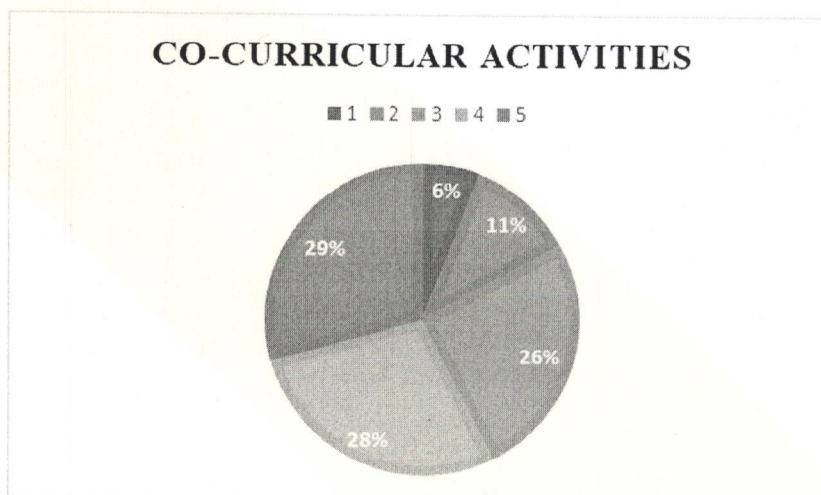
Feedback on the curriculum was collected by IQAC for the academic year 2020-21 and the following suggestions have been received from the students:

Report of student's feedback regarding college facilities

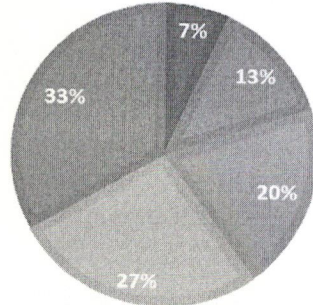
2020-21

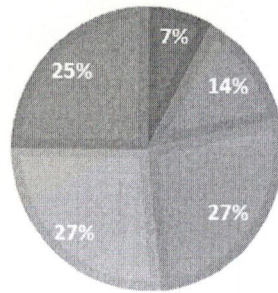
EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES


