

Feedback on Curriculum for the academic year 2021-22:

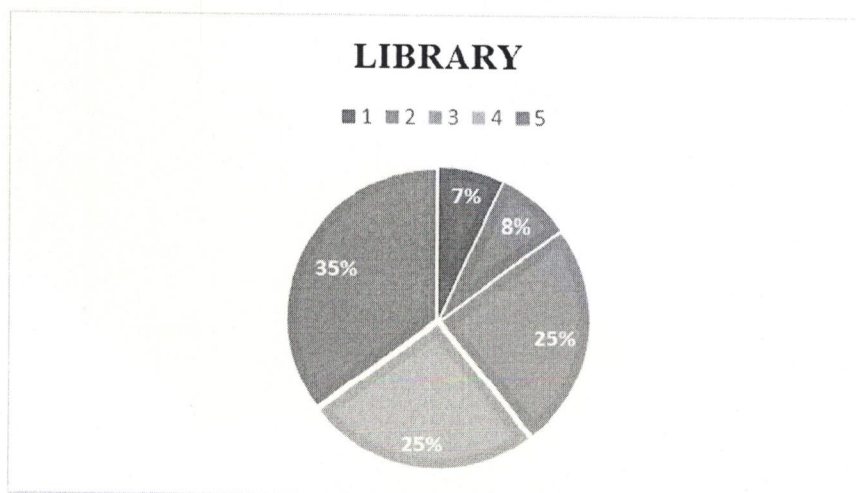
Feedback on the curriculum was collected by IQAC for the academic year 2021-22 and the following suggestions have been received from the students:

Report of student's feedback regarding college facilities

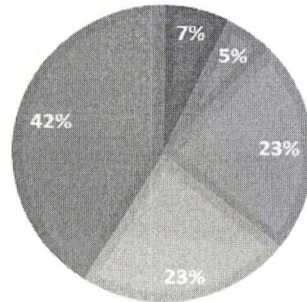
2021-22

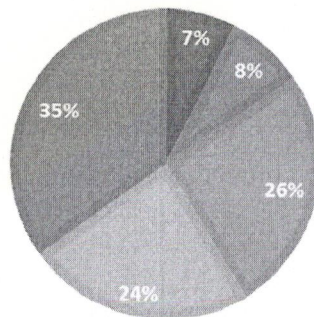

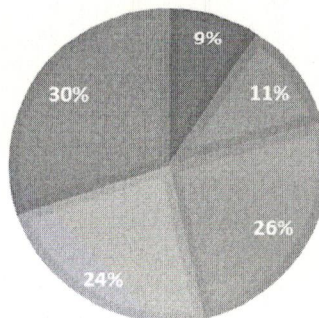

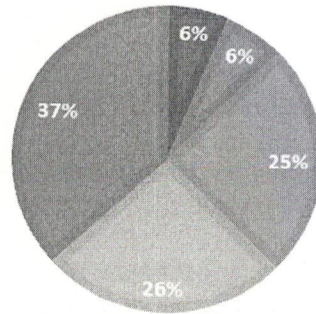
CANTEEN

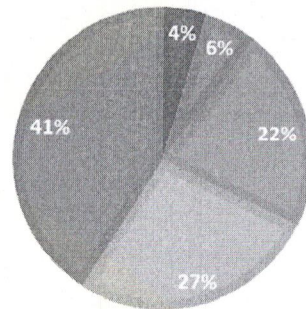
CLEANLINESS & HYGIENE

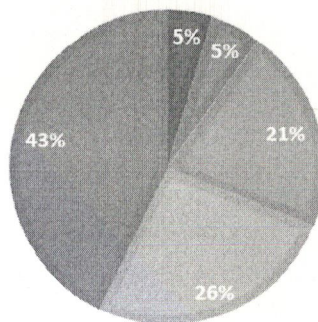
CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

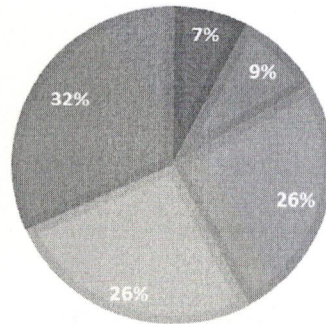
EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

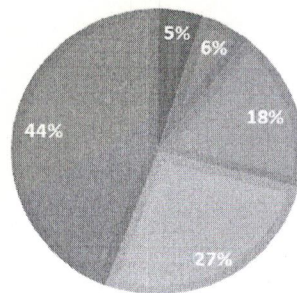




ONLINE TEACHING & LEARNING SUPPORT
